VISIT TO GODINTON HOUSE

We have arranged a private tour of Godinton House at 11am on Wednesday 4th September.

Godinton House is an ancient Jacobean house complete with a medieval hall, with beautifully furnished rooms offering 500 years of history, plus 12 acres of formal and wild gardens. It is situated on the A20 just east of Ashford. From junction 9 on the M20 follow signs for Lenham A20. About a quarter of a mile after the second roundabout there is a signpost for the house on the left opposite the Hare and Hounds pub.

The cost is £8 per person. A ploughmans lunch plus tea or coffee is available afterwards at an additional £8 per person. If a ploughmans is required please specify from a choice of cheese, ham, pate or mixed cheese and ham.
